Purpose of Scholarship:

The EHSBSB will award scholarships to help defray the cost of post-secondary education and recognize the achievements of eligible EHS Boys Soccer athletes.

Essay Scholarship Offering:

To be awarded \$500 based on an essay submitted by the applicant. The essay shall be 300-500 words and must address the following concepts:

Jim Tufts was a long time teacher and soccer coach at EHS. He also became involved with Special Olympics in 1970, and volunteered in many capacities with them for decades. This scholarship is intended to honor both his passion for soccer and volunteering. Please write a short essay (can be in resume form) about how you have displayed a commitment to soccer and volunteering as demonstrated by Jim Tufts. If applicable, please list volunteer activities with dates and organization. Preference given to applicants that participated in unified sports or the Special Olympics.

Requirements:

Scholarship applicants shall be a full-time EHS student and must have participated in the EHS soccer program a minimum of three full years (or equivalent of half your tenure at EHS if EHS is not your only high school) (one of which must be athlete's senior year).

General Information:

All completed applications must be turned in to the Scholarship Committee or, in any year in which no Scholarship Committee is appointed, to the EHS Guidance Department, no later than the deadline listed in the Scholarship application. All scholarship applications which do not have the required information or are not submitted by the deadline will be considered incomplete and, therefore, ineligible, and will be returned to the applicant.

Scholarship awards are not based upon financial need.

Students who receive a full post-secondary education scholarship (for any reason) are not eligible to receive a scholarship from EHSBSB. The term "full post-secondary scholarship" refers to the payment in full of tuition, room and board for a full school year by any combination of scholarships or grants but shall not include loans taken out by the athlete or the athlete's family to pay for the athlete's post-secondary education.

Both the Academic and the Essay scholarships cannot be awarded to the same senior. The award of the Academic Scholarship will take priority. For this purpose, a runner-up Essay Scholarship winner will be chosen from the entrants during the selection process.

Payment of Scholarship:

The applicant's enrollment in an educational institution accredited by the US Department of Education (college, university, trade school, military academy, etc.) is a requirement for receiving scholarship funds. Disbursement checks for all scholarship funds shall be made payable jointly to the institution and the student. Proof for disbursement of funds shall include a verification of enrollment from the Institution after the start of the school year for which the scholarship has been awarded.
